Dilated Pre-op Exam: The Eye Institute Laser Vision Center provides a free screening to determine if you are a good candidate for refractive surgery. A dilated pre-op exam is also required prior to surgery and can be done at the time of your screening or once a surgery date is scheduled.

Payment Options

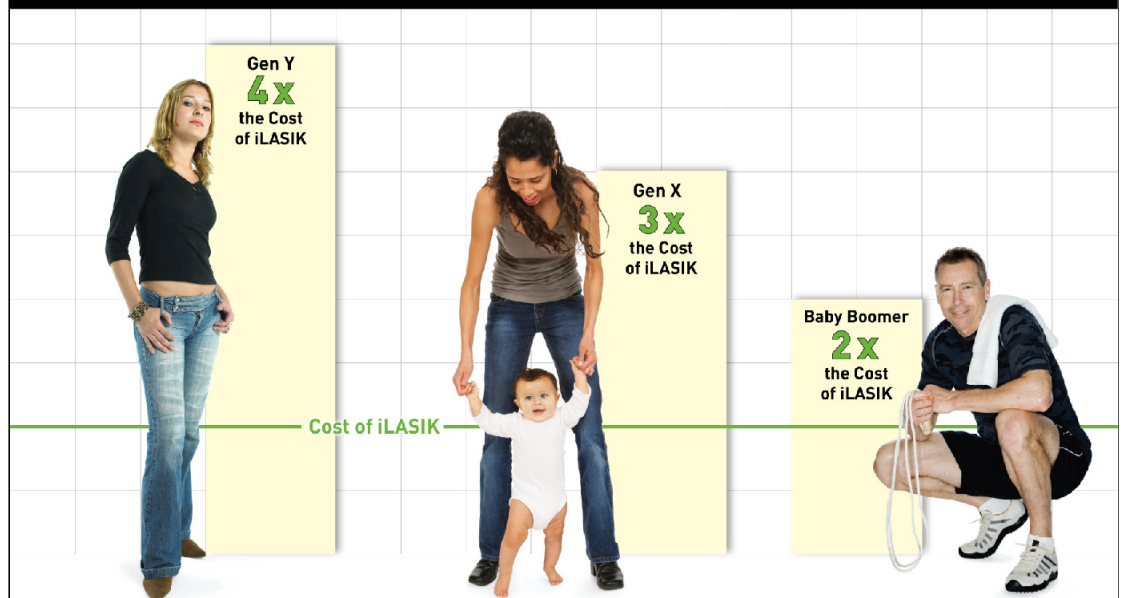
- 1) Payment in Full:** Full payment is required the day of surgery. We accept cash, credit card (Visa, MasterCard, and Discover), or cashier's check payable to Black Hills Regional Eye Institute.
- 2) Care Credit Financing:** Care Credit offers a full range of payment including no interest and extended payment plans. You must be approved prior to surgery. Apply online at www.lasikrapidcity.com.
- 3) Insurance:** It is the patient's responsibility to determine insurance eligibility for LASIK or PRK. Any potential coverage will **not** be honored if discussed after surgery.



All Prices Include:

- 1) All-laser custom LASIK or PRK (the same technology approved for military and NASA pilots).
- 2) One year of post-op care.
- 3) Surgery kit with artificial tears samples, goggles for sleeping, sunglasses, and relaxing medication for surgery day.
