

# Getting to New England Eye Center in Boston (Via Public Transportation)

### By Train (MBTA and Commuter Rail)

The Tufts-New England Medical Center Orange Line stop is located across the street from the main hospital entrance at 830 Washington Street. Other nearby MBTA stops are: Downtown Crossing (Red and Orange lines) and Boylston Street (Green line).

Tufts-New England Medical Center is a 10-minute cab ride (traffic permitting) from Logan Airport, and is within walking distance of South Station, a major station for commuter and interstate rail systems. It also is convenient to bus lines 3, 11, 43, 55 and the Silver Line.

# Getting to New England Eye Center - Boston (By Car\*)

#### From the North

From I-93, as you enter the tunnel off the Leonard Zakim/ Bunker Hill Monument bridge, move to the right lane and take "Right Exit 20A South Station". Go straight at the light at the end of the exit ramp, and carefully move across to the right lanes. Proceed to the last stoplight and be sure you are in the right-most lane. Turn right onto Kneeland Street where there is a sign, "Chinatown." Go straight for several blocks, and then turn left on Tremont Street. The Tufts-NEMC garage is on your left just past the Wang Center.

### From the South

From the South: From I-93 take Exit 20 "Rte. 90 (symbol) / Logan Airport / Worcester / South Station" and immediately get into the left-hand lane. Take the left exit where the overhead sign reads: "Detour South Station via Frontage Road." Follow the signs to Downtown until you see a ramp marked "South Station, Downtown." On that ramp, stay left and follow the arrows to "Chinatown." Bearing left will put you on Kneeland Street. Go straight for several blocks, and then turn left on Tremont St. The Tufts-NEMC garage is on your left just past the Wang Center.

# From the West

Take the "South Station" exit (#24-A) from the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90). Turn left on Kneeland Street and left again on Tremont Street. The Tufts-NEMC garage is on your left. \* These directions were updated in January of 2005. Due to ongoing road construction for the "Big Dig," these could change. Please check PRIOR to heading into town.

# Getting to New England Eye Center - Boston (SATURDAY DIRECTIONS)

- The front door to the New England Eye Center in the Biewend building, located on Tremont Street is closed on Saturdays.
- Please park in the Tremont Street garage located next to the Wang Center.
- Use the "C" elevators located in the back corner of the garage to enter the hospital.
- You may enter the hospital either at levels 2 or 3. There are just a few steps to walk up or down depending on the level from which you enter.
- Turn to your left after entering the hospital and walk down the glass walkway. Continue to walk through the double doors until you come to the green elevators. Take the elevators to the 11<sup>th</sup> floor.
- On a rare occasion the double door mentioned have been known to be locked. Should his happen, walk back through the glass walkway
  to the garage door and pick up the telephone. Call security at 67770 and tell them that you are at the garage door and have an
  appointment in the Biewend building. Security will either "Buzz" the double doors to unlock them or walk over to the doors to manually
  unlock them.
- Be sure to bring your garage ticket to the 11<sup>th</sup> floor and have it stamped for discounted parking.

# **Getting to New England Eye Center-Wellesley**

From the Massachusetts Turnpike, take Route 128 South.

From Route 9 (Brookline) take Route 128 North.

#### From Route 128 South

Exit 21B to Wellesley and Route 16. At the light, make a right onto Washington Street. Go through the next light and across the bridge. It is the first building on the right (across from the Sunoco station).

#### From Route 128 North

Exit 21 to Route 16. Turn left onto Washington Street and cross back over Route 128. Go a ½ mile through the second light. Cross the bridge over a river. It is the first building on the right, across from the Sunoco station.

#### From Newton

Take Route 16 (Washington Street) past Newton-Wellesley Hospital and across Route 128 toward Wellesley. After the second light, cross the bridge. It is the first building on the right, across from the Sunoco station.

### From Route 9 (Natick)

Exit Route 16 in Wellesley Hills and turn left onto Route 16 towards Newton. The building is on the left about 1/10 of a mile after Grossman's.

# Getting to New England Eye Center at Health Alliance - Leominster

# From Points East using Rte. 2

Take Rte. 2 to Leominster, Exit 32 (Rte. 13 South; Main Street). Take your first left after the bridge onto Haws Street. Take your first left turn and turn right at the end onto Commercial Road. We are in the AAA building on the left.

# From Points West using Rte. 2

Take Rte. 2 to Leominster, Exit 32. Follow the ramp to a stoplight at Haws Street. Turn left and go to lights at end. Turn left again onto Mill Street. At end of Mill Street, turn left again onto Commercial Street. Our parking lot is then a right turn.

#### **From Points South**

Take I-90 North to Rte. 2 West. Almost immediately, get off at Exit 32 and get on Rte. 13 South and follow the directions above.

### From Health Alliance Hospital

Take Rte. 12 (North Main Street) South to junction with Rte. 13 (Main Street). Turn left onto Mill Street. Continue East to end at Commercial Street. Turn left, then right into our lot at the AAA building on the right.
