

Laser Vision For Life Agreement

For Patients who are 20/20 best corrected pre-operatively. If after laser vision correction at Spectrum Lasik, the vision changes due to myopia regression and/or progression, to less than 20/40 unaided, we will be happy to offer a re-treatment procedure, with existing laser vision correction technology at no additional cost for life. This agreement includes post-operative exams for three months following the re-treatment procedure. This agreement does not include yearly eye health exams.

Requirements for enhancement surgery:

- 1. The vision reduction cannot be the result of an eye disease, injury, or temporary fluctuation in vision.
- 2. The advisability of re-treatment and the determination of the type of procedure will be at the surgeon's discretion.
- 3. To retain eligibility, the patient must have completed all post-operative examinations required by our facility. These are as follows: 1 day, 1 week, 1 month, and 3 months. In addition, patients are to have an eye health examination every 12 months at Spectrum Lasik, Clemson Eye, or with a qualified optometrist or ophthalmologist following laser vision correction.
- 4. Spectrum Lasik reserves the right to exclude certain complicated cases and presbyopia correction from this program.

Clinical eligibility:

Limited to patients undergoing an initial LVC for myopia (nearsightedness) of -6.00 diopters or less and astigmatism of -2.00 or less. Uncorrected vision less than 20/40 and demonstrated best corrected vision of better than 20/25.
